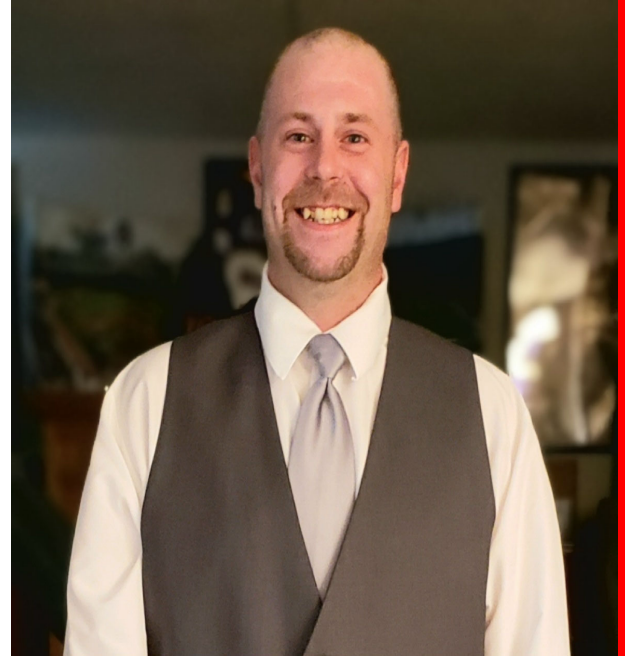




OFFICE SOUGHT: COUNCILMEMBER
