

Dog Park Rules & Regulations

1. Use park at your own risk. By entering this dog park, the park user agrees to hold the City of St. Francis harmless and free from liability from any action of any park users or their dogs. Park users agree to fully comply with the posted rules and take full legal liability from any action of their own or their dogs.
2. Dog owners are solely responsible for the actions and behavior of their dog(s). Please ensure dogs do not escape the fenced area.
3. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and leaving the park transition area. No retractable leashes are allowed.
4. Dogs must wear a collar with identification & current year license tags at all times.
5. Prong (spike) or choke collars must be removed prior to entry to dog park as they are prohibited.
6. Owner's must have their dog's vaccination certificate information readily available while in the dog park.
7. All dogs must have current rabies and all other vaccinations as required by Anoka County, the City of St. Francis, and the Department of Health; dogs must be free from contagious diseases and parasites.
8. Dogs with a known history of dangerous or aggressive behavior are prohibited.
9. Dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their owner/handler at all times. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if aggressive behavior is observed.
10. Never leave your dog unattended.
11. Limit 2 dogs, per person, per visit.
12. All St. Francis City Parks are closed between the hours of 10:00p.m. and 6:00a.m.
13. No female dogs in heat. Spayed/Neutered animals are recommended.
14. No puppies under 6 months of age; dog must be properly vaccinated.
15. Dog waste must be cleaned up by their owners IMMEDIATELY. Fill any holes your dog may dig.
16. No children under 12 years of age allowed. All Children under the age of 16 must be closely supervised by a parent and/or guardian and must behave appropriately: no running, shouting, chasing dogs, petting of other's dogs without the owner's permission.
17. Small Breed Section, no dogs OVER 25lbs allowed.
18. Animals other than dogs are not allowed.
19. No food or drink, (Human or Dog) or smoking allowed in the dog park enclosure or transition area.
20. Absolutely no bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, or any motorized vehicles, except those required for the physically challenged are allowed.
21. People must be wearing shoes while in the Dog Park and/or transition area.
