**DROP-OFF EVENT**

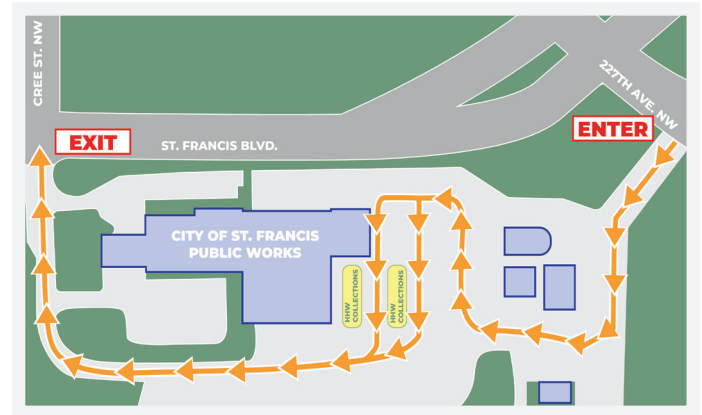
Products used to maintain your home, yard and vehicle or control pests can be hazardous. Drop them off at our free household hazardous waste collection event for safe disposal.

-  Light bulbs and string lights
-  Fluorescent lights
-  Gasoline\*
-  Household cleaners
-  Mercury thermometers
-  Needles and syringes
-  Paint
-  Propane tanks (full or empty)
-  Motor oil\* and filters
-  Vaping devices
-  Weed killer
-  Prescription medication

## COLLECTION EVENT DETAILS

### DAY OF EVENT:

1. Securely place items into your trunk or cargo bed, bring drivers license or proof of residency.
2. Enter event from 227<sup>th</sup> Ave NW.
3. Remain in your vehicle while staff unload accepted items.

## HOW DO I KNOW?

**Check the label.** If it says CAUTION, WARNING, DANGER or POISON, it doesn't belong in the trash unless the containers are empty.
